

# CHRISTOLOGY: Christ's Divine Names and Attributes

---

- A. All Divine Names and Titles apply to Christ. He is divine *esse* (pure and absolute act of Being). The same Person Who said “**I am** who **I am**” in Exodus 3:14 is the same Person Who said, “Before Abraham **I am**” in John 8:58: Jesus Christ. Names include:
1. God.
  2. The Mighty God.
  3. The Great God.
  4. Yahweh Lord.
  5. Lord of Lords.
  6. King of Kings.
  7. God over all.
- B. All Divine Attributes are ascribed to Him. He is divine *esse* (pure and absolute act of Being). The same Person Who said “**I am** who **I am**” in Exodus 3:14 is the same Person Who said, “Before Abraham **I am**” in John 8:58: Jesus Christ. Attributes include:
1. Sovereignty.
  2. Absolute righteousness.
  3. Justice.
  4. Love.
  5. Eternal Life.
  6. Omniscience.
  7. Omnipresence.
  8. Omnipotence.
  9. Immutability.
  10. Veracity.
- C. Christ is the Creator and Upholder of the Universe. All things are created by Him and are held together by Him, John 1; Heb. 1; Col. 1:16-17.
- D. Christ is the objection of
1. All worship—for all humans and angels.
  2. Christian sentiment.
  3. Reverence, love, faith, and devotion.
- E. To Him: Men and angels are responsible for their character and conduct.

- F. It is required that:
1. Men should honor Him as they honor the Father.
  2. They should exercise the same faith in Him that they do in God the Father.
- G. Christ declares that He and the Father are one, and that those who have seen Him have seen the Father also, John 14:9.
- H. Christ calls all men unto Him and promises:
1. To forgive their sins.
  2. To send them the Holy Spirit.
  3. To give rest and peace.
  4. To raise them up at the last day.
  5. To give them eternal quality of life (at the moment of believing)
- I. God is not more than, cannot promise more than, or do more than Christ is said to be, to promise, and to do.
- J. Christ has, therefore, been the Christian's God from the beginning in all ages, and in all places.
