

#### DAILY DOCTRINE

Divine Promises for the faith-rest life

**Definition: Faith-rest is a problem solving device that God has provided for the believer to handle problems of life. In faith-rest the believer takes a promise from the Word of God and applies it to the problem(s) of life. Faith-rest is available for every believer—even the baby believer.**

#### A. Promises to use for the problem of worrying and depression.

1. Romans 8:28, And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to *His* purpose.
2. 1 Peter 5:7, casting all your anxiety upon Him, because He cares for you.
3. 1 Thessalonians 5:18, in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
4. 1 Corinthians 1:9, God is faithful, through whom you were called into fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
5. 1 Samuel 17:47, and that all this assembly may know that the LORD does not deliver by sword or by spear; for the battle is the LORD's and He will give you into our hands."
6. 2 Timothy 1:7, For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline.
7. Matthew 21:22 "And all things you ask in prayer, believing, you shall receive."
8. Philippians 4:19 And my God shall supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
9. Exodus 14:13 But Moses said to the people, "Do not fear! Stand by and see the salvation of the LORD which He will accomplish for you today; for the Egyptians whom you have seen today, you will never see them again forever. <sup>14</sup> "The LORD will fight for you while you keep silent."
10. Psalm 4:8 In peace I will both lie down and sleep, For Thou alone, O LORD, dost make me to dwell in safety.
11. Psalm 56:3 When I am afraid, I will put my trust in Thee
12. Isaiah 40:31 Yet those who wait for the LORD Will gain new strength; They will mount up *with* wings like eagles, They will run and not get tired, They will walk and not become weary.
13. Isaiah 26:3 "The steadfast of mind Thou wilt keep in perfect peace, Because he trusts in Thee.
14. Isaiah 41:10 'Do not fear, for I am with you; Do not anxiously look about you, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, surely I will help you, Surely I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.
15. Romans 8:31 What then shall we say to these things? If God *is* for us, who *is* against us?
16. Romans 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?

17. Philippians 1:6 *For I am* confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus
18. Philippians 3:14 I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. <sup>15</sup> Let us therefore, as many as are perfect, have this attitude; and if in anything you have a different attitude, God will reveal that also to you;
19. Philippians 4:6 Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, shall guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

**B. Promises to use when praying for the unsaved.**

1. 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.
2. Acts 16:31 And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you shall be saved, you and your household."
3. Acts 17:26 and He made from one, every nation of mankind to live on all the face of the earth, having determined *their* appointed times, and the boundaries of their habitation, <sup>27</sup> that they should seek God, if perhaps they might grope for Him and find Him, though He is not far from each one of us;
4. John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life

**C. Promises to use to get back in fellowship—and stay in fellowship!**

1. 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness
2. Hebrews 12:1 Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance, and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, <sup>2</sup> fixing our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
3. 1 Peter 2:1 Therefore, putting aside all malice and all guile and hypocrisy and envy and all slander, <sup>2</sup> like newborn babes, long for the pure milk of the word, that by it you may grow in respect to salvation.
4. 1 Corinthians 2:16 For who has known the mind of the Lord, that he should instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ.

**D. Promises regarding present eternal life and security.**

1. John 10:28 and I give eternal life to them, and they shall never perish; and no one shall snatch them out of My hand.
2. John 10:29 "My Father, who has given *them* to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch *them* out of the Father's hand.
3. John 10:10 "The thief comes only to steal, and kill, and destroy; I came that they might have life, and might have *it* abundantly.
