JEWISH APOLOGETICS (44)
ANSWERING JEWISH OBJECTION #35
(DDR #663)

Objection #35: We dealt with Christianity nineteen hundred years ago. There were great Jewish leaders alive in Jesus' day and in the decades following. They watched him, they watched his followers, and they rejected the whole thing for good reason. There's nothing to discuss.

This is the last objection covered in Michael Brown's first volume. He only provides a short response to this objection:

Then why are you reading this book? Why are Jewish scholars reevaluating their views about Jesus? Why have Jewish leaders and even rabbis become believers in Yeshua through the centuries? The fact is, our forefathers who rejected Yeshua made a wrong turn and got off track. Now, there's only one thing to do: Turn around.¹

This concludes a look at his first volume. In the next DDR we will move to his second volume on *Theological Objections*, where the objections are more serious and complex as they deal with the Trinity and the deity of Jesus Christ.

It is possible that I will be sending out several DDRs in a day over the next week as I try to get caught up and move toward our next series on the resurrection of Jesus Christ.
