DAILY DOCTRINE
Redemption from the Slave Market of Sin

1. All have sinned, Romans 3:23.
2. Three categories in the human race.
 - a. Religious, Romans 4:4. All good works are debt.
 - b. Moral, Isaiah 64:6, "righteousness are as filthy rags."
 - c. Immoral, Romans 6:23, "the wages of sin is death."

3. All are born into the Slave Market of Sin.

John 8:34 Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who commits sin is the slave of sin. ³⁵ "And the slave does not remain in the house forever; the son does remain forever.

4. Only one way out

John 14:6, Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father, but through Me.

John 8:36 "If therefore the Son shall make you free, you shall be free indeed.

5. Only a free man can free a slave:

- a. Only Jesus Christ was born free from sin (with a sin nature) and did not commit personal sin, cf. 2 Cor. 5:21.

- b. Jesus was born of a virgin. This was necessary because the OSHGEN is passed down by the father (Rom. 5). Jesus had no human father (Matt. 1:20). Therefore He had no OSHGEN. Therefore He was a free man, not born in the Slave Market of Sin.

6. The Lord Jesus Christ bought us (paid the price) from the Slave Market of Sin.

1 Peter 1:18 knowing that you were not redeemed with perishable things like silver or gold from your futile way of life inherited from your forefathers, ¹⁹ but with precious blood, as of a lamb unblemished and spotless, *the blood* of Christ.

1 Corinthians 6:20 For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.

7. This basic freedom is the freedom on which all freedoms are based. It is always related to right relationship with God.
