DAILY DOCTRINE: Baptism of Fire

1. The Baptism of Fire is the judgment that comes at the second advent. Unbelievers are cast of the earth, believers go into the millennium.
2. Doctrine of the Baptism of Fire is stated in Matt. 3:11-12; Luke 3:16-17; 2 Thess. 1:7-9.
3. Analogy *as* the Baptism of Fire.
 - a. Matthew 24:37-41, "As the days of Noah were . . . "
 - (1) One taken in judgment: the unbeliever.
 - (2) One left to go into the millennium: the believer.
 - b. See Isaiah 13:9-10.
4. Parables of the Baptism of Fire:
 - a. Wheat and tares: Matthew 13:24-30, 36-43.
 - (1) Wheat: Believers go into the millennium.
 - (2) Tares: Unbelievers are cast off, burned up.
 - b. Matthew 13:47-50
 - (1) Good fish: believers
 - (2) Bad fish: unbelievers



- c. Matthew 24:43-51. The good man of the house.
 - d. The Ten Virgins: Matt. 25:1-13.
 - e. The Sheep and Goats: Matthew 25:31-46.
 - (1) Sheep: Gentiles who go into the millennium.
 - (2) Goats: Gentiles who are taken in judgment.
 - f. The Talent Test: Matt. 25:14-30.
 - (1) The five and two talent man (Jew) goes into the millennium.
 - (2) The one talent man goes into judgment.
5. Baptism of Fire from the standpoint of the Gentiles. The “nations” are the Gentiles, Matt. 25:32.
6. Baptism of Fire from the standpoint of the Jews. When the Jews are brought back into the land, the unbelieving Jews are judged and cast off the earth and the born-again Jews will go into the millennium.
