



A DICTIONARY OF TERMS

The purpose of these notes is to present in simple terms grammatical usage and terms found in the printed notes and sermons. An attempt has been made to avoid complicated and technical definitions.

1. ANTHROPOLOGY – the doctrine of man.
2. ANTHROPOPATHISM – ascribing human feelings or emotion to God such as “repent,” “grieve,” “anger,” etc.
3. ANTHROPOMORPHISM – ascribing some human form to God such as “eyes of God,” “hand of God,” “arm of the Lord,” etc.
4. ANGELOLOGY – doctrine of angels.
5. ANTI-SEMITISM – hostility in thought or action against the Jews.
6. BELIEVER – a person who has received Christ as personal Savior (John 1:12).
7. BIBLIOLOGY – doctrine of the Bible.
8. CANON – books of the Bible recognized as genuine and inspired.
9. CARNALITY – the state of a believer controlled by the old sin nature.
10. CHRISTOPHANY – an appearance of Christ in bodily form before His incarnation.
11. DEITY – the character or nature of God; Jesus Christ is undiminished deity.
12. DEMONOLOGY – doctrine of demons (fallen angels).
13. DIALECTIC MATERIALISM – basic doctrine of Communism.
14. DISPENSATIONS – Divine categories, and/or the divine outline of human history expressed in terms of divine revelation. In every age or dispensation, the plan of God operates through an agency, such as Israel or the Church.
