INTRODUCTION

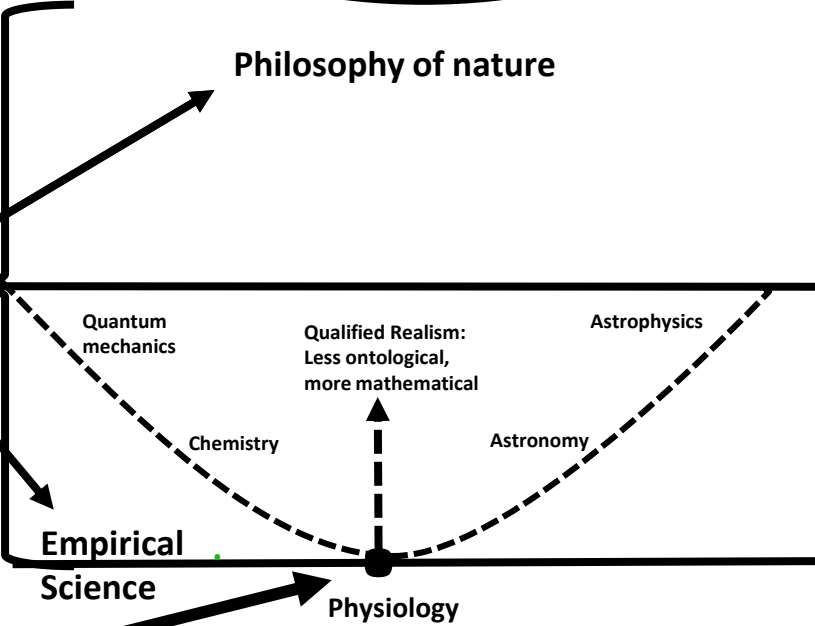
Alive to the glory (beauty) of divine greetings: 1 Thess. 1:1-4; 1 Cor. 1:1-5.

1. Alive to the glory (beauty) of proper knowledge and proper love of God: Matt. 22:37-40; Job 1:20-22; Hab 3:17-18; James. 1:17-18; John 1:1-18; Col. 2:3; Heb. 1:1-3; Psa 36:8-9; 16:11; 1 Cor. 2:6-9; 1 John 2:15-16; Philip. 4:6-9; Psa 73:24-25.
2. Alive to the glory (beauty) of the Scriptures: 1 Thessalonians- Galatians 5. What is more beautiful, a sunset or an epistle, why?
3. Alive to the glory (beauty) the hermeneutics of realism (PR): breaking out Heidegger's Dasein and linguistic communities.
4. Alive to the glory (beauty) of reality and science as such: Psa. 19; Rom. 1:20.

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SUPREME BEAUTY: SUPERNATURALLY SEEING THE GLORY/EFFULGENCE OF CHRIST IN FAITH-KNOWLEDGE

- 1. The nature of the supreme beauty, glory, of Christ's form as the centerpiece of faith-knowledge revelation: John 1:4-9; 14:9; Heb. 1:1-3; Col 1:19, 2:9.**
- 2. Beholding the radiant beauty, the glory, of Jesus Christ and the problem of subjective blindness to infinite beauty/glory of God: 2 Cor. 4:4-6; Psa 46:10; 16:8; Mat 13:13; Jer. 7:24; Rom. 1:18-20.**
- 3. The nature of the relationship between faith-knowledge and the other two fundamental virtues: hope and love: Rom 5:1-5; Col. 1:3-5; 2:3; 1 John 3:2-3; 1 Pet 1:13, 20-21; 3:15.**
- 4. Alive to supreme beauty, glory, of the form of faith-knowledge: the Son of God: Heb. 1:1-3; John 1:1-18; 1:37-51; 14:9; Col. 1:15-20, 2:9; 1 John 1:1-3; 2 Cor. 3:18-5:8.**
