Communion: Metaphysics of God's Love (Feb. 4, 2018)

Jn 3:16; 1 Jn 4:10, 16; Rom 5:5; 1 Cor 13:12-13; 16:22-24; Matt. 22:37-39.

A. Biblical testimony to Christian experiences directly from God (Rom 5:5; 1 John 3:24; 4:7-8, 13; 1 Thess 1:5; Psa. 34:8; Rom 8:15-18; Gal. 4:6).

B. Reflecting on the metaphysical nature of God's Love.

1. The unchanging God of love, Ex. 3:14; James 1:17; Mal. 3:6; 1 Jn 4:8.
2. The gratuity of God's creative love.
3. The intimacy of friendship with God.
4. Divine compassion (referential multivocity), Jer. 31:3; Ex 34:6.
5. Incarnate Love and the Church, Jn 1:14, 18; Rom 5:8; Jn 15:13; Matt 25:35-40; Acts 22:6-8; Rom 12:4-5; 1 Cor 12:12; Col. 1:24.

C. Love and spiritual virtue.
