## Broad and deep understanding of BD

## Mature Believer - Level 3- Metaphysical Maturity

- High abstract metaphysical understanding of BD; Esse, HU, Trinity, Evil, Good,
- Enormous capacity for synthesis of BD and grasping of spiritual realities.
- Required to understand Trinity, free will, evil, good, the human soul, the hypostatic union, substances and properties, philosophy of mind.

## Young adult - Level 2- Doctrinal conceptualization

- Things in terms of Bible doctrine that is undergirded by biblical passages

## Baby & meaning of life

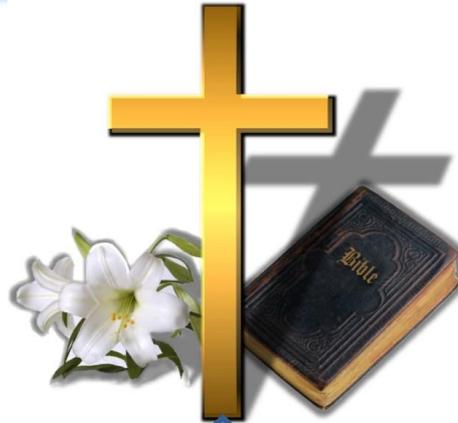
- Limited to isolated Bible verses
- Does not apply doctrine or divine viewpoint to all the issues of life
- Fragmented understanding of truth.

**Emphasis on reason in Classical Approach Illustrated  
(Peter Kreeft, "*Between Heaven and Hell*")**

John Kennedy: If you want to be so logical, I challenge you: prove to me logically that Jesus is God and not just man.

C.S. Lewis: All right.

Kennedy: What?

Lewis: I just said, "All right." Why the surprise?

Kennedy: I thought you were going to say something about mysteries and faith and authority and the church. Do you mean you are going to *reason* yourself into the old faith?

Lewis: Not myself; I'm already there. But you, perhaps.

Kennedy: Did you reason yourself into it? Did you arrive at your belief by reason alone?

Lewis: Reason *alone*? Of course not. But I looked before I leaped. I reasoned before I believed. And after I believed too—I mean, once I believed, I was convinced by the way reason backed up faith. It couldn't prove *everything*, but it could give very strong arguments for many things, and it could answer all objections.

Kennedy: *All* objections?

Lewis: Certainly.

Kennedy: That sounds pretty arrogant to me. Who are you to answer all objections?

Lewis: No, No, I don't claim that *I* can answer all objections but that *reason* can—all objections are answerable.

Kennedy: Why do you believe that?

Lewis: If truth is one, if God is the author of all truth, both the truth of reason and the truth of faith (I mean divine revelation), then there can never be a rational argument against faith that's telling, that's unanswerable. Faith may go beyond reason but it can never simply contradict reason.

“Problem” of Evil-18:  
Job 9: Job 9; Internal Integration and God

1. Outline of Job 9: Job’s First Spiel on the Problem of Evil.
  - a. God is Almighty, 9:1-7.
  - b. God is Omniscient, 9:8-10
  - c. Job cannot struggle against God, 9:11-21.
  - d. The Evil Lot of the Just and the Wicked, 9:22-35.

2. Before one can grasp the problem of Evil in any depth, a great deal of background knowledge is required, e.g.,
  - a. Analytical (left-brain skills) precise knowledge.
  - b. Narrative (right-brain skills) for nuanced understanding necessary for interpersonal relationships.
  - c. 1<sup>st</sup> person knowledge of self as person.
  - d. 2<sup>nd</sup> person knowledge of God as a Person
  - e. 3<sup>rd</sup> person “that” knowledge about God (Bible doctrine).
  - f. Personal internal integration and the presence of God.

3. Example of analytical framing of the “problem.”
  - a. God is omniscient—He knows about all evil.
  - b. God is omnipotent—He is able to stop evil.
  - c. God is love—He desires to remove evil.
  - d. Yet, evil, much evil continues to exist.
  
4. Narrative understanding of evil. We will be filling in the background knowledge with Job, Samson, and Mary of Bethany.

5. The inadequacy of 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> person knowledge.
- ✓ The distinction between 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> person knowledge on a natural and supernatural level.
  - ✓ It is the “that knowledge.” Gnosis knowledge.
  - ✓ As far as God and Bible doctrine, 3<sup>rd</sup> person knowledge is the how and what knowledge.
  - ✓ This would be associated with the analytical knowledge.
  - ✓ This is just talk about God.
  - ✓ Strengths provides accurate understanding of Bible doctrine and the nature of God.
  - ✓ Weaknesses if not coupled with 2<sup>nd</sup> person knowledge: legalism, self-righteousness, lack of spiritual life,
  - ✓ This is the main problem of Job as well as Eliphaz and Bildad.

## 6. The need for 2<sup>nd</sup> person personal knowledge.

- ✓ Knowing God personally.
- ✓ Relationship knowledge.
- ✓ Impossible apart from the ministry of the Holy Spirit.
- ✓ Greatest source of power and motivation in the world.
- ✓ Weaknesses: without correct 1<sup>st</sup> person knowledge, this knowledge is fallible and can lead to mysticism, fanaticism, and heretical views as per liberalism and the Franciscans.
- ✓ On a human level deficiencies in 2<sup>nd</sup> person experiential knowledge have analogies to autism (serene self-sufficiency, lack knowledge of persons and their mental states, lack of personal connectedness).
- ✓ Biblical narratives provide aid in translating 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> person truths into 2<sup>nd</sup> person knowledge. Narratives tend to resonate more than formulas on a personal level.
- ✓ Perhaps lack of capacity for 2<sup>nd</sup> person knowledge and love toward fellow believers may be related to not being able to connect to God on a 2<sup>nd</sup> *PERSON* level.
