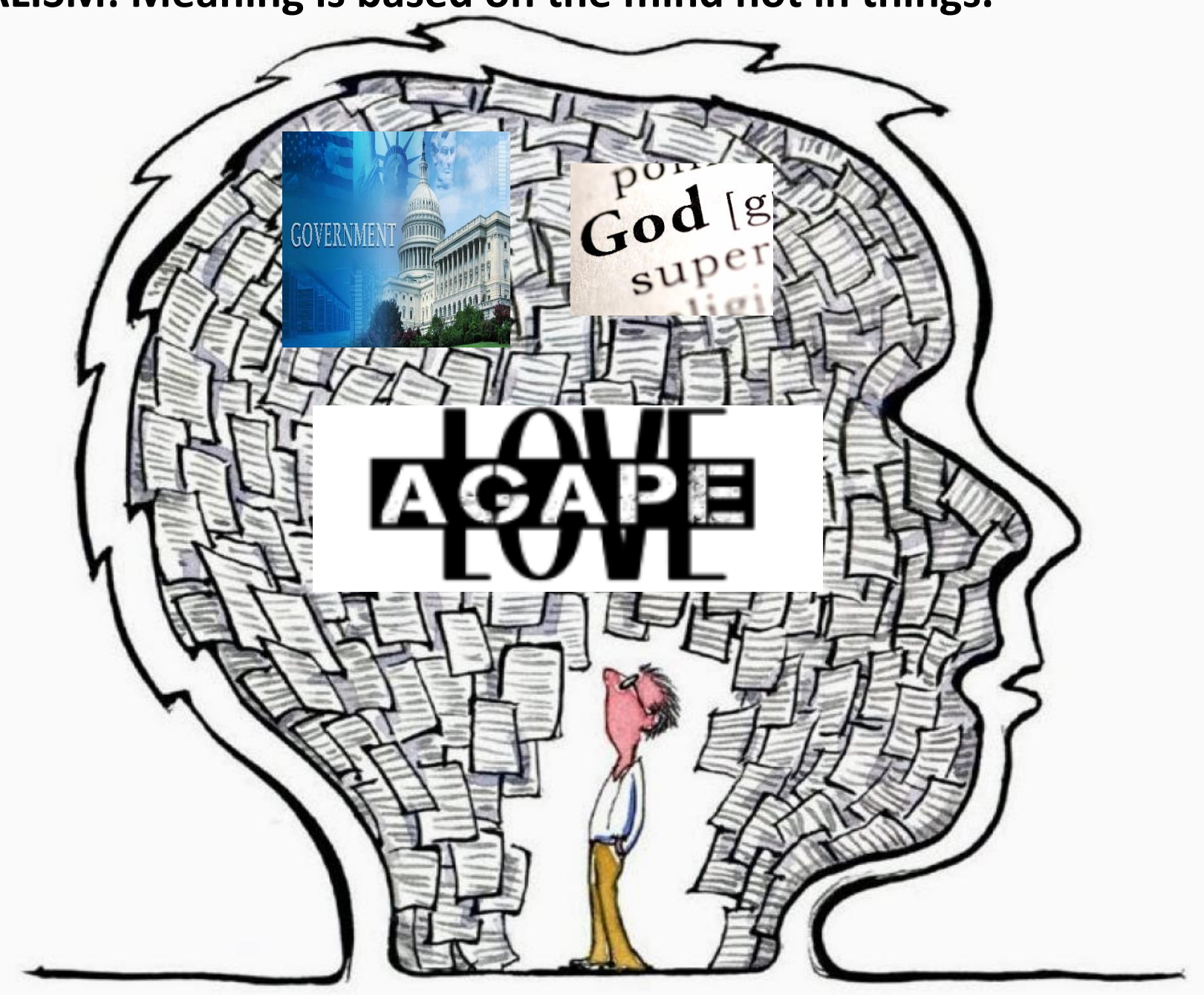
**NEW TESTAMENT USE OF AGAPE/LOVE**
