B. Bible doctrine:

1. Loving God—self-denial (Mark 12:28-34; Luke 9:23; 1 Pet 2:21-24; Eph. 5:25-28; Col 3:12-14); the temptations and nature of the world: Luke 4:3-12; Revelation 4-6.
2. Love in 1 Cor 13:1-5: . . . ‘love thinks no evil’ (οὐ λογίζεται τὸ κακόν).
3. Blessedness, salt, light, and government—the SEP challenge, Mt 5:13-16.
 1. 3 main SEP systems: Capitalism, Marxism, Socialism.
 2. 5 principles of Marxism:
 - a) Philosophy: Dialectical materialism.
 - b) History: Economic interpretation of history.
 - c) Economics: Labor theory of value.
 - d) Sociology: Progressive pauperization.
 - e) Politics: Overthrow by revolution.
 3. Idealism vs. reality: the history of Britain, France, Germany, Sweden, European Union, Soviet Union, Soviet Bloc, China, Asian Tigers (South Korea, Singapore, Taiwan), and the United States.
 4. Scripture on SEP matters (Jas 4:4-5:6; Acts 2:42-45; Rev. 17-18; Rom 13:1-8; 1 Tim. 2:2-4; 1 Pet 2:9-14; Ex 22:22; Lev. 19:9-10; 23:22; Deut. 15:1, 11; 24:17-21; Isa 1:11-17; 3:14-15; Jer. 7:5-11; 22:13-19; Micah 2:1-2; 3:9-12; Amos 2:6-8; 5:24; 8:4-6; Ezek. 16:49).
