- A.** Discipleship and the Holy Spirit—1 Cor 3:7; John 7:17, 37-39; Gen 2:10; Num. 20:2-11; Psa 42:1; Rev. 22:1-3; John 14:15-26; Gal 5:13-26; 1 Thess. 5:12-22; Eph 4:17-5:2.
- B.** Six areas of transformation:
1. Thoughts: the mind (ideas, images, information, reasoning)
 - a. The American problem of divorcing faith from knowledge.
 - b. The American problem of the secularization of Christian knowledge.
 - c. The four ultimate questions of life.
 2. Feelings: affections, emotions, dispositions, experiences, attitudes.
 3. Heart: will, character, choices, direction, goals.
 4. The body: service for the lord, control, sanctity.
 5. The social life: loving others, helping others, sociability.
 6. The soul: integration of the whole life, life flow, and energy.
- C.** Matthew 5-7: the Beatitudes.
