1. History on 4 SEP systems: ~~1) 4 Capitalisms~~, 2) **Christian socialism: 1st generation in Victorian England**, 3) ~~Marxism (atheistic)~~, 4) ~~Atheistic socialism/communism.~~
1. Economic idealism vs. economic reality: the history of ~~Britain (47%), France (57%), Germany (45%), Sweden (53%), European Union (1951-), Soviet Union (1917-1991), Soviet Bloc, East Germany, West Germany, China (45%), Asian Tigers (SK 40%, Singapore, Taiwan), and the United States (18th-20th).~~

1st Generation: Christian Socialism -1800's Victorian England

1. Understanding socialism.
 - a. Broadest concepts: individualism/capitalism vs societal/socialism.
 - b. Marxist socialism: the democratization of production.
 - c. Lenin vs. Stalin: democratization of production; State Capitalism
 - d. Other socialisms: different forms of socialism are informed by different values in different cultures.

2. Bird's eye view of economic history.
 - a. Feudalism: lord and serf. Very organized and rigid.
 - b. French Revolution: destroy Feudalism; proletariat/employee; freedom.
 - c. State Capitalism: Soviet Union. State/employee
 - d. America: FDR's social gospel to James Fifiield's corporate Christianity

3. Christian socialism in Victorian England = SEP actions for all people.
 - a. Not to be confused with Marxism.
 - b. Frederick Denison Maurice (1805-1872). Anglican theologian and priest.
 - c. John Ludlow (1821-1911): founder of Christian socialist newspaper
 - d. Charles Kingsley (1819-1875): critical of conservative (LF) Christianity.
 - e. Thomas Hughes (1822-1896): authored "Christian socialist."
