Opening: John 19:1-30.

A. The Christian as a sojourner (παρεπιδήμιος) in the world.

1. Hebrews: **religious/transcendent pressure**. 3 images:
 - a. The image of the Israelites in the desert, Heb 3:5-19.
 - b. The image Jesus as High Priest, Heb 9:11-14.
 - c. The image of spiritual heroes as sojourners, Heb 11:13-16.
2. James: **economic pressure**, James 1:1.
 - a. The challenge of the world's standards, 2:1-7.
 - b. The pressures of the world's economics, 4:3-5:6
3. 1 Peter: **political/social pressure**,
 - a. Public disapproval, 2:11-17.
 - b. Verbal abuse, 2:21-23.

B. Revelation: the culmination of religious, economic, and political conflict on God's people.
